Essential Job Functions (Including but not limited to):

- Use laser tracking equipment on customer job sites and in the shop.
- Maintenance and operation of a variety of field machining equipment, including services such as pipe beveling and cutting, line boring, flange facing, among other creative applications.
- Keeps equipment available for use by inspecting and testing; completing preventive maintenance such as, disassembly, inspection, reassembly, function test, final inspection, and proper packaging.
- Maintains equipment functional condition by listening to operator/customer complaints; conducting inspections; repairing equipment failures; repairing mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic systems malfunctions; replacing parts and components; repairing cosmetic damage.
- Operates portable machining equipment in various locations such as Power Plants, Paper Mills, Shipyards, Manufacturing Plants, Chemical Plants, Refineries, Steel Mills, Mines, Wind Farms, and on Heavy Equipment.
- Constant client communication. You will be your client's main point of contact onsite. This communication includes job start introductions, managing timeline expectations throughout a job, and relaying feedback to the Mactech team.

Required Skills:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Ambitious and works at a quick pace, but with diligence and attention to detail.
- Basic understanding of mechanical, hydraulic and electrical systems.
- Maintain a neat and organized work area.
- Place safety and quality at the forefront.
- Ability to read and understand schematics and assembly drawings.
- Ability to work with other team members, highly flexible, "Get it Done" attitude.
- Time management skills, the ability to schedule and prioritize tasks unsupervised.
- Mechanical aptitude or ability to learn about our products, retain and apply the information.
- Ability to read and comprehend instructions & procedures and perform basic math.
- Quality Control, Drafting/AutoCAD and Engineering backgrounds are a plus.

Physical Demands:

- Stand, walk, sit, use hands to fingers, handle or feel objects and tools, frequently the employee will be required to bend, squat, kneel, stoop, reach, twist, climb, rotate and crawl.
- Lifting and or moving limitations will require regular lifting or moving of 50 pounds or less.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work:

- Days and hours of work are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. when you are in the shop.
- When working onsite you may be required to work 12+ hour shifts for 7-day work weeks for multiple weeks at a time.
- Working overtime as needed.

Work Environment:

- Working with, in or around exposures to high noises, chemicals, vibrations, hot/humid, cold conditions, and other outside weather conditions.

Travel:

- 60% travel is expected for this position when working onsite.
- Frequent overnight travel is also expected.

Required Education and Experience

- High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- 2+ years of mechanically inclined experience, does not have to be field machining

Additional Eligibility Qualifications:

- Must have a valid Driver license, or State issued photo ID
- Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC)
- Must have no felonies within the last 7 years and must not be listed on any domestic or international watch lists
- Successful completion and passing of fit for duty physicals, background checks and drug & alcohol testing programs
